
Shoreline Motor Hotel Rally

STAGE 1 - Starts 9:00am (6km long) best viewing from start, finish or Old North Road/ Shortcut Rd intersection.

STAGE 2 - Starts 9:23am (16km long) Best viewing from start or finish

STAGE 3 - Starts 10:08am (59km long)

Best viewing from start or finish.

Nenthorn Rd, Moonlight Rd.

STAGE 4 - Starts 12:38pm (15km)

Best viewing from start, finish or Lee Flat Road.

STAGE 5 - Starts 1:18pm (17km)

Viewing difficult and only from start and finish.

STAGE 6 - Starts 1:43pm (40km)

Viewing not recommended but see inset on map.

STAGE 7 - Starts 3:00pm (12km)

Viewing good, best from Flagstaff Rd carpark.

MOTE: To get from Start to Finish of Stage 3, go north to Palmerston, follow highway 85 to approximately 18 kms to turn off to Macraes Flat. Go to Macraes Flat and continue on Macraes Rd to Highway 87, where you turn left and go to Middlemarch.

Lunch break at Middlemarch. First car arrives approx 11:00am and leaves approximately 12:00am.

DO . . .

Don't stand on the outside of a corner

Don't assume that rally cars are arriving at even 1 minute gaps
