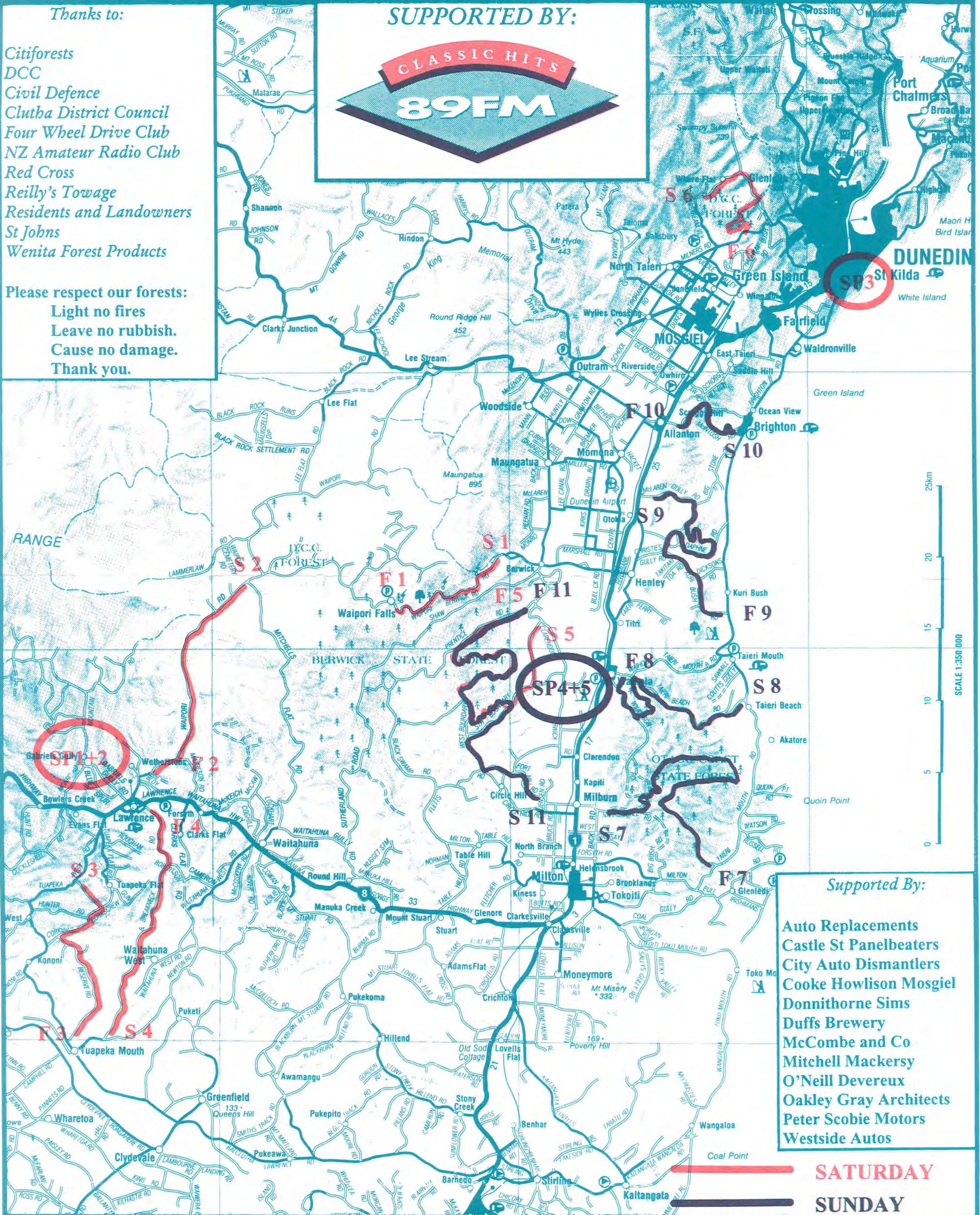

The road is only open after a special stage when the tail car goes by. The Tail Car is clearly marked. Until it arrives expect a rally car at any time, even if there has been a long break.

SATURDAY 16 MAY

Cars leave the **SHORELINE HOTEL** and proceed to the Octagon. first car there at 9.50am for a formal start over the start ramp at 10.00 am.

Special Stage 1 13.6km **Waipori Gorge** First Car Starts at 10.45am Best viewing from the start and finish, but limited.

Special Stage 2 17.2 km **Mahinerangi** 11.20am Best viewing from the intersection mid stage, with Matheson Rd, off Highway 8, and finish.

Service Park 1 at Lawrence. First car arrives at 11.40am and stays 20 minutes. Note the Lawrence Service Park is a big feature with the cars visiting it twice.

Special Stage 3 16.9km **Corkscrew Rd** 12.15pm Best viewing from the intersection mid stage, with Hunter Rd, off the Balclutha - Lawrence Rd, or in via Tuapeka Flat Rd.

Special Stage 4 19.2km **Breakneck Rd** 12.40pm Best viewing from either of the side roads intersecting mid stage.

Service Park 2 and regroup at Lawrence. First car arrives at 1.00pm approx and leaves at precisely 1.30pm.

Special Stage 5 28.5km **Berwick Forest** 2.25pm Best viewing from intersections near Waiholo Hill, or with West Boundary Rd or finish.

Special Stage 6 11.5km **Whare Flat** 3.30pm Best viewing from the Pineapple track carpark, start and finish.

After stage 6 the cars proceed over the finish ramp at the Octagon (1st car 4.00pm), then on to the Timaru St Service Park

Service Park 3 at Timaru St. First car arrives at 4.15pm and stays 2 hours. From here cars go into an overnight safe storage.

THE DO'S AND DON'TS

- Don't assume that the rally cars will arrive at even intervals
- Do please leave your dog at home

SUNDAY 17 MAY

The first car leaves the **SHORELINE HOTEL** at 7.45am and heads straight to stage 7.

Special Stage 7 26.8km **Akatore** First Car Starts at 8.35am Best viewing at start and finish. Mid stage access from Akatore will be blocked

Special Stage 8 17.2km **Taieri Beach** 9.15am Best viewing from Waiholo Taieri Beach Rd, start and finish.

Service Park 4 at Waiholo. First car arrives at 9.35am and stays 20 minutes.

Special Stage 9 25.1km **McLaren Gully Rd** 10.15pm Best viewing from any of the intersecting roads.

Special Stage 10 8.5km **McIntosh Rd** 11.00am Best viewing from intersection mid stage. Access via Law Rd or Brighton - Scroggs Hill Rd.

Service Park 5 and regroup at Waiholo. First car arrives at 11.25 approx and leaves exactly at 11.55am.

Special Stage 11 28.0km **Fort Hill** 12.15pm Best viewing from any of the intersecting roads or the start and finish.

Regroup at Start of SS12. First car arrives at 1.30pm approx.

Special Stage 12 2.0km **Super Special - Wharf area, beside old Anzac Ave overbridge** First Car Starts at 1.45pm Best viewing from the overbridge and any of the intersections. It will be fast and spectacular!!! Four laps of a block travelling sideways.

After stage 12 the cars proceed on to the **SHORELINE HOTEL** Parc Ferme (1st car 2.00pm)

THE SHORELINE CLASSIC RALLY

A feature repeated from last year is the Classic Rally. This is for pre 1982 two wheel drive vehicles. Vehicles will range from Mk1 Escorts and Datsun P510's through to such cars as Alan Dippie's MGB, and the BDA Escort of Jeff Judd which won the 1982 NZ rally championship.

The Classic rally was a real success last year, and many people are now picking it to be the next major growth area in our sport. It is a lot of fun and drivers can just enjoy competing in a vehicle they particularly like, not being concerned on whether it is the latest model.

A feature of the classic rally is the more relaxed rules. Unlike the 'main' rally servicing will be allowed anywhere, and competitors will be able to miss a stage and join in again later.

The Classic Rally will run as a separate group of cars, after the main rally, and will be started in reverse seeded order, slowest to fastest.

RALLY CAR SHOW AND FORUM

Between 6pm and 8pm on Friday 15 May the top rallycars and their crews will be on show at Turners Car Auction, off Portsmouth Drive. Make the most of this excellent opportunity to see the cars and have a talk to the drivers.

After the show meet NZ's top drivers at the Rally Forum, 8pm at Regines bar, at the Shoreline Hotel.

It will be a lighthearted evening, watching and listening to the videos, stories and future plans from these competitors. Last year it proved extremely popular, with 300 people enjoying an excellent night.
