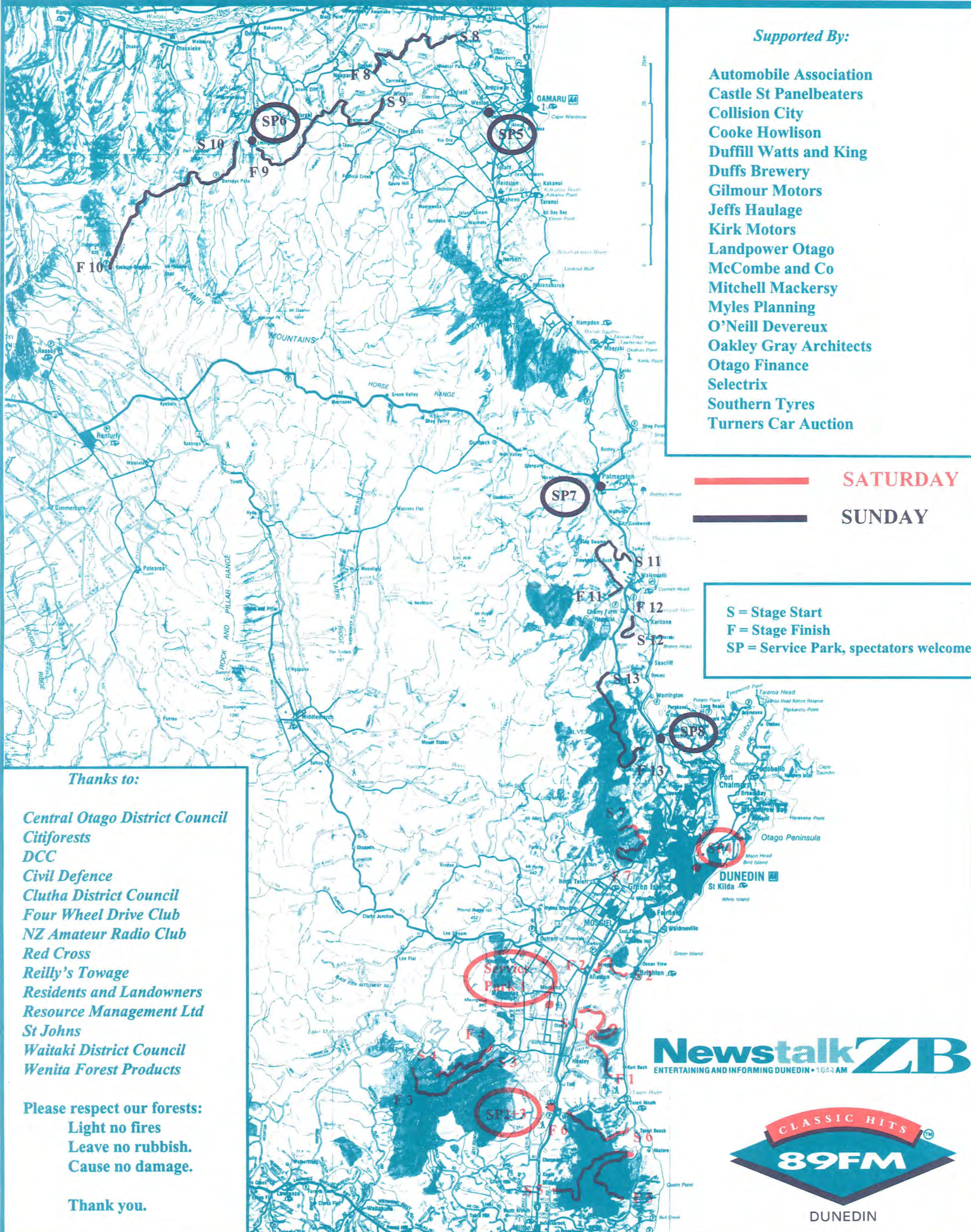

SATURDAY 15 MAY

Cars leave the **SHORELINE HOTEL** and proceed to the Octagon, first **Classic** car there at 9.50am for a formal start over the start ramp at 10.00 am.

Special Stage 1 **Cooke Howlison Toyota McLaren Gully Rd.** First **Classic** Car starts 10.30am
25.0km
Best viewing from any of the intersecting roads.

Special Stage 2 **Oakley Gray Architects McIntosh Rd** 11.15am
8.2km
Best viewing from intersection mid stage. Access via Law Rd or Brighton - Scroggs Hill Rd.

Service Park 1 at Kirks Drain Rd. First car arrives at 11.30am and stays 20 minutes.

Special Stage 3 **Gilmour Motors Shaws Hill Rd** 12.05pm
17.0km
Best viewing from the start, but limited.

Special Stage 4 **McCombe and Co Waipori Gorge** First Car Starts at 12.30pm
13.5km
Best viewing from the start and finish, but limited.

Service Park 2 at Waihola. First car arrives at 12.55pm and stays 20 minutes. Note this service park is a feature, with cars visiting it twice.

Special Stage 5 **Castle St Panel Beaters Akatore** First Car Starts at 1.35pm
26.8km
Best viewing at start and finish. Mid stage access from Akatore will be blocked

Special Stage 6 **O'Neill Devereux Taieri Beach** 2.15pm
17.2km
Best viewing from, start and finish off Waihola Taieri Beach Rd.

Service Park 3 at Waihola. First car arrives at 2.30pm and stays 20 minutes.

Special Stage 7 **Mitchell Mackersy Whare Flat** 3.45pm
11.5km
Best viewing from the Pineapple track carpark, start and finish.

After stage 7 the cars proceed over the finish ramp at the Octagon (1st car 3.45pm), then on to **Service Park 4** at Timaru St. First car arrives at 4.10pm and stays 2 hours.

The road is only open after a special stage when the tail car goes by after the MAIN FIELD. The Tail Car is clearly marked. Until it arrives expect a rally car at any time, even if there's been a long break.

THE SHORELINE CLASSIC RALLY

A feature repeated from last year is the Classic Rally. This is for pre 1982 two wheel drive vehicles. Vehicles will range from such cars as Alan Dippie's MGB, and the BDA Escort of Jeff Judd which won the 1982 NZ rally championship.

The Classic rally was a real success last year, and many people are now picking it to be the next major growth area in our sport. It is a lot of fun and drivers can just enjoy competing in a vehicle they particularly like, not being concerned on whether it is the latest model. A feature of the classic rally is the more relaxed rules. Servicing is allowed anywhere, and competitors will be able to miss a stage and join in again later.

New for 1999 the Classic Rally will run as a separate group of cars, before the main rally, and started in reverse seeded order, slowest to fastest. There will only be a very short gap between the Classics and the following field. Expect the first National Championship car immediately after the last classic.

THE DO'S AND DON'TS

Rallying is a spectacular sport to watch and we hope that you will come out and follow it. There are a few safety rules that you must observe as there is no guarantee that the cars you are watching are under control!!

- Don't assume that you can hear a car coming
- Don't stand on the outside of a corner
- Do stand where you can make a hasty escape or are safe from a car crashing
- Don't assume that the rally cars will arrive at even intervals
- Do please leave your dog at home

SUNDAY 16 MAY

The first **Classic** car leaves the **SHORELINE HOTEL** at 6.30am and heads straight to **Service Park 5** at Weston, arriving at 7.50am for 15 minutes, then straight to stage 8.

Special Stage 8 **Otago Finance Ridges Rd** First **Classic** Car Starts at 8.20am
22.1km
Best viewing at start and finish or any of the mid stage access roads.

Special Stage 9 **Landpower Otago Tokarahi** 8.55am
27.6km
Best viewing from start and finish or any of the mid stage access roads.

Service Park 6 at Livingston. First car arrives at 9.20am and stays 20 minutes.

Special Stage 10 **Selectrix Danseys Pass** 9.55am
30.0km
Only viewing from start and finish.

Service Park 7 at Palmerston. First car arrives at 11.20am and stays 20 minutes.

Special Stage 11 **Myles Planning Waikouaiti** 11.55am
16.0km
Best viewing mid stage, especially intersection south of Waikouaiti.

Special Stage 12 **Duffill Watts and King Apes Rd** 12.25pm
7.5km
Best viewing from start or especially the mid stage access.

Special Stage 13 **Duffs Brewery Silverpeaks** 12.50pm
20.5km
Best viewing from the start and finish, but access is difficult.

Service Park 8 at Waitati. First car arrives at 1.25pm approx.

Special Stage 14 **Classic Hits/Newstalk ZB Super Special Wharf area, beside old Anzac Ave overbridge**
2.0km
First **Classic** Car Starts at 2.10pm. Main field follows the classics, as per the rest of the rally. Best viewing from the overbridge or any intersection. Fast and spectacular!!! Four laps of a block travelling sideways.

After stage 14 the cars proceed on to the **SHORELINE HOTEL** Parc Ferme (1st car 2.25pm)

RALLY CAR SHOW, FORUM AND QUIZNIGHT

Between 6pm and 8pm on Friday 14 May the top rallycars and their crews will be on show at Turners Car Auction, off Portsmouth Drive. An excellent opportunity to see the cars and have a talk to the drivers.

At 8pm after the show meet NZ's top drivers at the Rally Forum, Regines bar, the Shoreline Hotel. It will be a lighthearted evening, listening the stories and plans of NZ's best competitors. In previous years this has been a very popular evening, with 300 people enjoying a great night.
