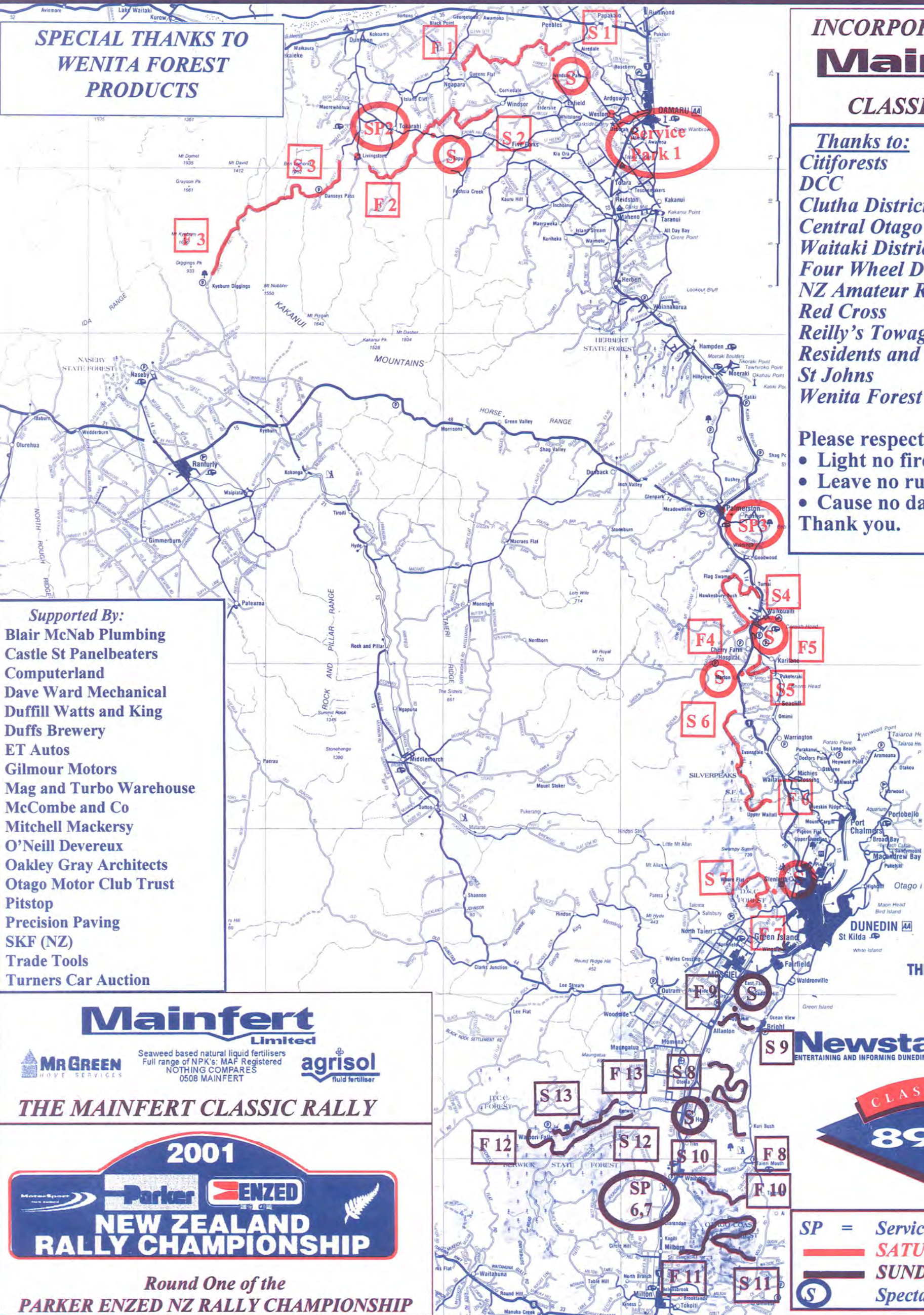

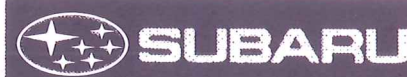

Best viewing at start and finish or from the McLeod/HorseGully Rd intersection mid stage.

Special Stage 2
27.0km
Blair McNab Plumbing Tokarahi 9.25am
Best viewing from start and finish or from Crown Hill Rd/Cant Rd, accessed from Five Forks side.

Pitstop Service Park 2 at Livingston. First car arrives at 9.50am and stays 20 minutes.

Special Stage 3
29.3km
Castle St Panelbeaters Danseys Pass 10.30am
Only viewing from start and finish.

Mag and Turbo Warehouse Service Park 3 at Palmerston. First car arrives at 11.55am and stays 30 minutes.

Special Stage 4
16.0km
Dave Ward Mechanical Waikouaiti 12.50pm
Best viewing mid stage, at the Sizemore Rd intersection south of Waikouaiti.

Special Stage 5
7.3km
Duffill Watts and King Apes Rd 1.20pm
Best viewing from start or especially the Apes Rd intersection mid stage, accessed off SH1.

Special Stage 6
15.9km
SKF (NZ) Silverpeaks 1.45pm
Only viewing from the start and finish, but access is difficult.

Mag and Turbo Warehouse Service Park 4 Timaru St, Dunedin. First car arrives at 2.35pm, and stays 20 minutes.

Special Stage 7
11.5km
ET Autos Whare Flat 3.30pm
Best viewing from the Pineapple track carpark midstage, and finish.

After stage 7 the cars proceed to Service Park 5, Timaru St, 90 minutes service (1st car 3.55pm)

SPECIAL GUEST COMPETITORS

Russell Brookes from England and twice British Champion will be competing in the Classic Rally in a full spec BDA Escort.

Ross Dunkerton from Australia, twice Asia Pacific Champion and multiple Australian Champion will be competing in the Classic Rally in a very special Datsun 240Z.

SAFETY - THE DO'S AND DON'TS

Rallying is a spectacular sport to watch and we hope that you will come out and follow it. The safety rules are important as the cars you are watching may not be under control.

Do: Always obey a marshal.
 Stand in naturally protected area.
 Please leave your dog at home.
 Understand that a car can crash in a very unpredictable way and place

Don't: Don't assume that you can hear a car coming
 Don't stand on the outside of a corner
 Don't assume you can make a hasty escape from a car crashing. There's never time
 Don't assume that the rally cars will arrive at even intervals.

The road is only open after a special stage when the "Sweeper" car goes by after the Main field. It is clearly marked. Until it arrives expect a rally car at any time, even if there has been a long break.

First Classic Car leaves the Parc Ferme at 7.30am and proceeds directly to Special Stage 8.

Best viewing from intersection with Christies Gully Rd.

Special Stage 9
8.2km
McCombe and Co McIntosh Rd 8.50am
Best viewing from intersection mid stage. Access via Law Rd.

Trade Tools Service Park 6 at Waihola. First car arrives at 9.15am and stays 20 minutes. Note this service park is a feature, with cars visiting it twice.

Special Stage 10
10.0km
Mitchell Mackerys Taieri Beach 9.50am
May be cancelled due to road conditions. Viewing only from start and finish.

Special Stage 11
26.6km
O'Neill Devereux Akatore First Car Starts at 10.15am
Best viewing at start and finish. No mid stage access possible.

Trade Tools Service Park 7 at Waihola. First car arrives at 10.50am and stays 20 minutes

Special Stage 12
16.4km
Oakley Gray Architects Shaws Hill Rd 11.35am
Only viewing from the start, but limited.

Special Stage 13
13.2km
Precision Paving Waipori Gorge First Car Starts at 12.00pm
Only viewing from the start and finish, but limited.

Duffs Brewery Service Park 8 at Fryatt St. First car arrives at 1.00pm and stays 10minutes. Then to Neutralisation Zone.

Special Stage 14
2.1km
Classic Hits Super Special. First Classic starts at 2.10pm.
Wharf area, beside old Anzac Ave overbridge. Main field follows the classics in reverse order. View from the overbridge or any intersection. Four fast and spectacular laps of the block.

Immediately after stage 14 a prizegiving ceremony will be held at stage 14 in front of the overbridge.
