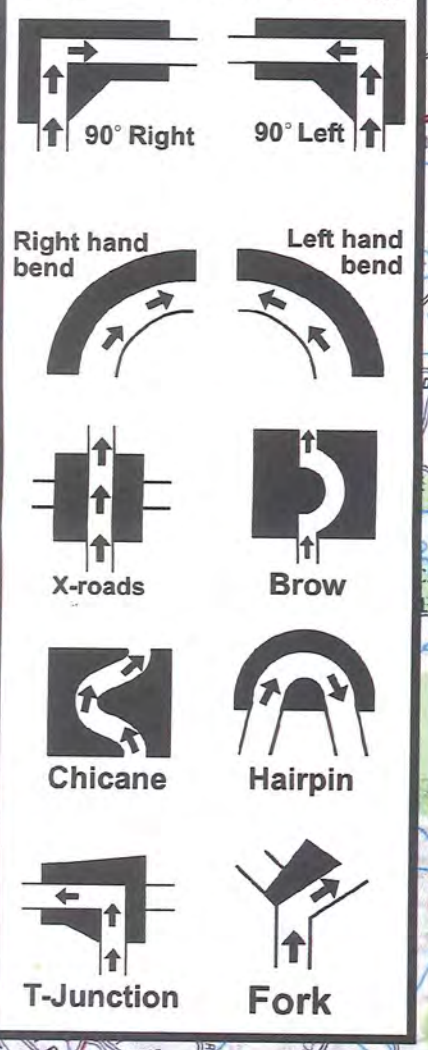

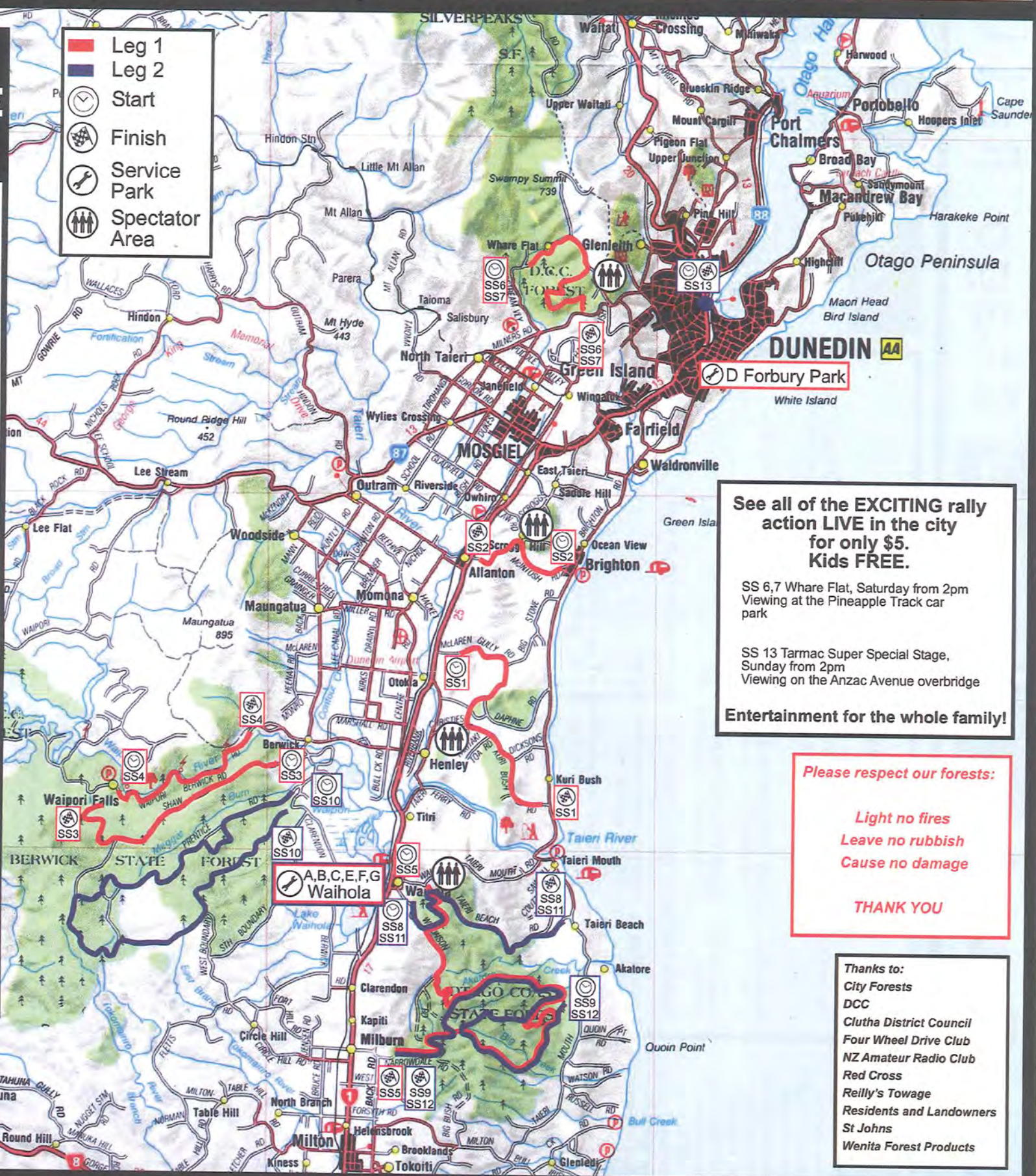
STAND SOMEWHERE SAFE

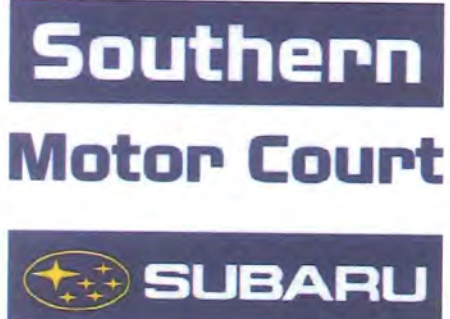

Town Hall Motorshow

Between 5pm and 9pm on Friday the 9th May the top rallycars, their crews and other exotic cars will be on show at the Town Hall Motorshow. This is an excellent opportunity to see the cars and have a talk to the drivers. There will be videos playing and 4XO will be there promoting the event. Last year huge crowds came to see the show.

From 7pm onwards there will be a **Rally Forum** where the top National Competitors and overseas guests will talk about their experiences and plans. There will also be the opportunity to ask your own questions. No where else will you get the opportunity to meet 2 former World Champions!

There will be a \$2 cover charge.

Saturday 10th May 2003

The first **Classic** car leaves **QUALITY HOTEL** at 8.15am and heads straight to Special Stage 1. *The National Championship field will follow the Classics with a gap of only a few minutes.*

Special Stage 1 15.0km **Blair McNab Plumbing McLaren Gully.** First Classic Car Starts at 8.50am
Best viewing from intersection with Christies Gully Rd.

Special Stage 2 8.25km **Castle Street Panelbeaters McIntosh Rd.** 9.25am
Best viewing from intersection mid stage. Access via Law Rd.

Waihola Store Service Park A, Waihola. First car arrives at 9.50am for 20 minutes.

Special Stage 3 17.0km **Computerland Shaws Hill.** 10.35am
Only viewing from start.

Special Stage 4 12.9km **Dave Ward Mechanical Waipori Gorge.** 11.10am
Only viewing from the start and finish, but limited.

Waihola Store Service Park B at Waihola. First car arrives at 11.35am for 30 minutes.

Special Stage 5 36.1km **EB McDonald Skyline.** 12.15pm
Best viewing from start and finish.

Waihola Store Service Park C at Waihola. First car arrives at 1pm, for 20 minutes.

Special Stage 6 11.4km **Gilmour Motors Whare Flat 1.** 2.05pm
Best viewing with commentary from the Pineapple track carpark midstage.
\$5 ENTRY FEE, KIDS FREE.

Special Stage 7 11.4km **McCombe & Co Accountants Whare Flat 2.** 3.25pm
A repeat of Stage 7, for the National Championship field only.

After Whare Flat the cars proceed to **Wilson Brothers Service Park D, Forbury Park**, 90 minutes service (1st Classic Car due at 2.40pm, first National Championship car at 3.50pm)

Sunday 11th May 2003

First Classic Car leaves the **Dorchester Finance Parc Ferme** at 7.00am and proceeds directly to Special Stage 8.

Special Stage 8 18.0km **Mitchell & Mackersy Taieri Beach 1.** First Classic starts 7.50am.
Best viewing from start and finish and intersection midstage between Skyline Rd and Waihola - Taieri Mouth Rd.

Special Stage 9 28.0km **Oakley Gray Architects Akatore 1.** 8.20am
Best viewing at start and finish..

Waihola Motors Service Park E at Waihola. First car arrives at 8.55am for 20 minutes.

Special Stage 10 37.3km **O'Neil Devereux Berwick Forest.** 9.45am
Good viewing at finish and intersection midstage at end of West Boundary Rd.

Waihola Motors Service Park F at Waihola. First car arrives at 10.40am for 20 minutes.

Special Stage 11 18.0km **Precision Paving Taieri Beach 2.** 11.15am.
Best viewing from start and finish and intersection midstage between Skyline Rd and Waihola - Taieri Mouth Rd.

Special Stage 12 28.0km **Trade Tools Akatore 2.** 11.45am
Best viewing at start and finish..

Waihola Motors Service Park G at Waihola. First car arrives at 12.20pm for 15 minutes.

Special Stage 13 2.1km **4XO Super Special Stage 2.25pm**
Wharf area, beside old Anzac Ave overbridge. Main field follows the classics in **reverse order.** Best viewing with commentary from the overbridge or any intersection. Four fast and spectacular laps of the block.
\$5 ENTRY FEE, KIDS FREE.

At stage 13 immediately afterwards a prizegiving ceremony will be held in front of the overbridge.
